Experience and Aims

In 1999, with a long research career in toxicological pathology behind me, I decided with a number of colleagues to establish an international organization to promote cancer prevention in the countries of Asia, the result being the Asian Pacific Organization for Cancer Prevention (APOCP) and its official journal the Asian Pacific Journal of Cancer Prevention (APJCP).

From 2006 until 2012 I was employed as Head of the UICC Asian Regional Office, with the task of assisting where possible in promoting cancer control activities in the Asian-Pacific while acting as Chief Editor of the APJCP. This has included assisting other organizations in staging cancer congresses, including the ICC-4 in November 2011, the 6th to 8th APOCP General Assemblies and a number of other Conferences staged in 2013-2016. My main activity then focused on the journal until very recently handing over responsibility to a new chief editor. Now I am involved in a new project, the EurAsian Institute for Cancer Research, an NGO legally constituted in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan, as Vice-President for Asia. In addition, as adjunct Professor I continue to lay stress on teaching commitments in the area of epidemiology research and scientific English language use, most recently in various medical universities in Kazakhstan, and in Khon Kaen University, Thailand.
